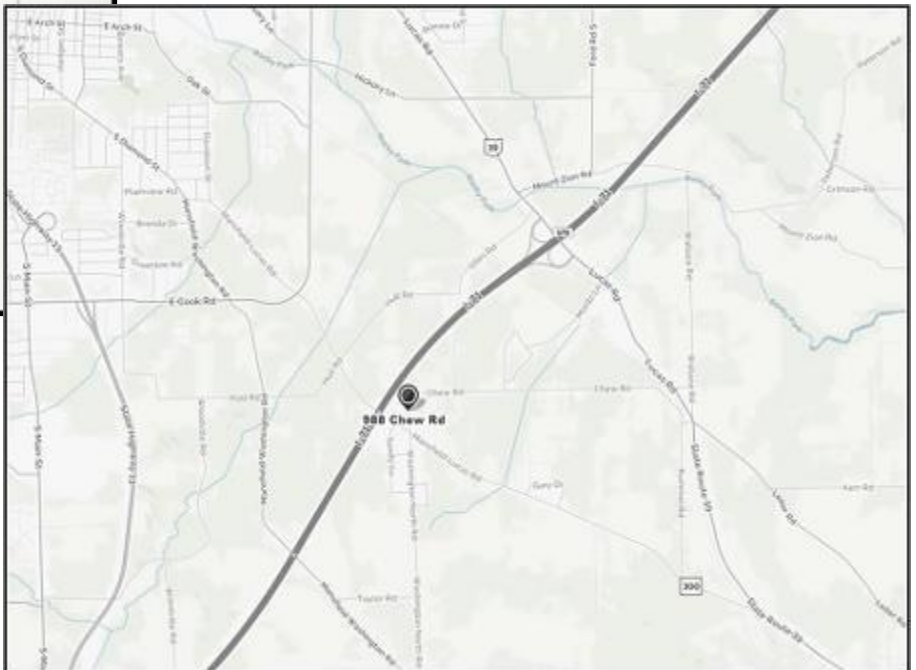
Sorry if I missed anyone. Saturday was a big day and some of our newbies I don't know.
