It is starting to get hot this summer, we have been busy clean up the yard and trimming trees. I shouldn't knock my head off mowing any more.

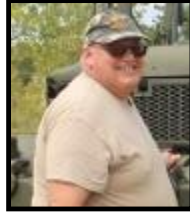
I hope everyone had a good time at the meeting at our place. It is a lot of work, but we enjoy doing it.

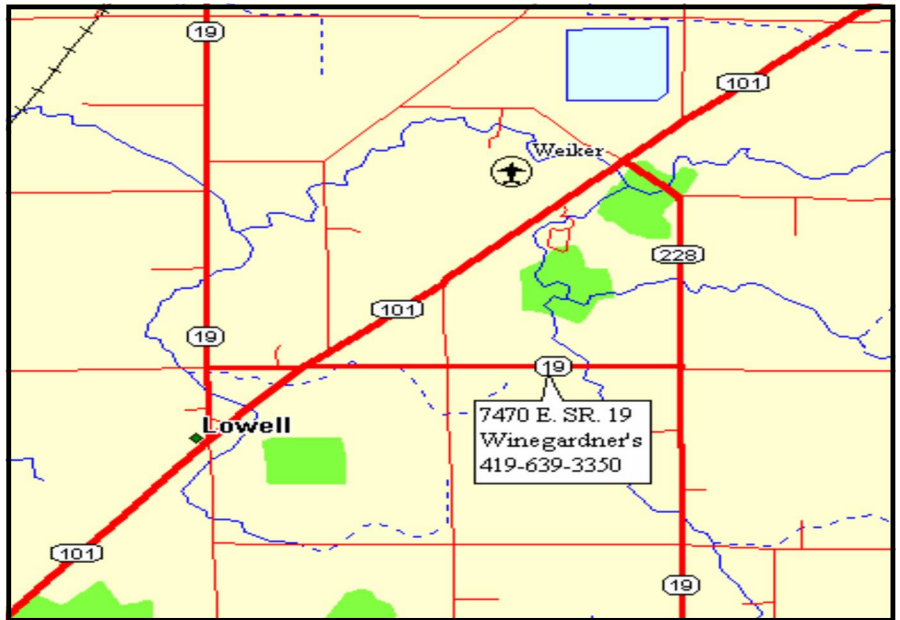
MEMBER UPDATES - I've heard of quite a few members with medical concerns this month. So, please keep your prayers coming.
