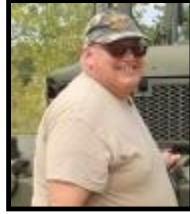

Editor Says...Hi Everyone!

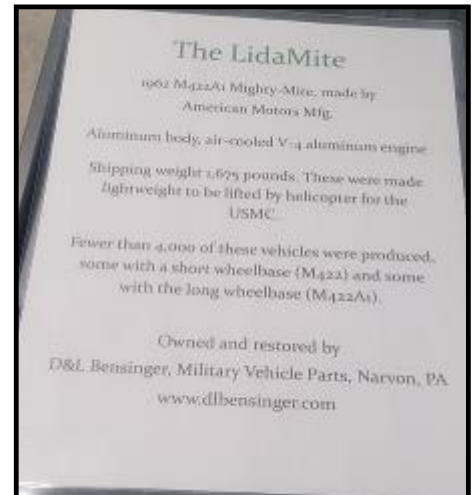
This summer is just passing us by. Hopefully we can keep having the great weather we've had recently. Cooler with low humidity.
