Directions to the Casslers' House

4400 Argyle Rd., S.E., Canton, Ohio 44707 From the North or South...

Take Interstate 77 into Canton and proceed to US Route 30. Go east on Rt. 30 to the second exit – State Route 43 South to Waynesburg. Exit there and proceed south on Rt. 43 for 2 miles to Sandy Ave. There is a church on the left and Sandy turns right. Go right on Sandy and travel 1.6 miles to Argyle Drive. (If you reach the stop sign at Baum Road, you have gone too far. Turn around and go back 100 yards.) Turn left onto Argyle and take it to the top of the hill. Ours is the white house on the right with the 4 large pillars and the circular driveway in front – 4400 Argyle Rd.

From the East or West...

Take US Route 30 to Canton and proceed to the State Route 43 South exit to Waynesburg. Go south on Rt. 43 and follow the directions as above.

From Louisville, Alliance & Youngstown...

Take US Route 62 to Canton and merge with Interstate 77 south. Follow 77 south to Rt. 30 east, then follow directions as in the instructions to the left.

From Carrollton, Waynesburg & Malvern...

Take Rt. 43 north to Baum Rd. (approx. 5 miles north of Waynesburg). Turn left on Baum and proceed west to Sandy Ave. Turn right on Sandy & proceed north about 100 yds. to Argyle. Turn right onto Argyle and proceed to top of hill – white house on the right.






