



MEMBER UPDATES -


I haven't heard anything bad so I guess we could be starting out the year with no major health problems. I know though we still have people recuperating so our prayers go out to them.



Meet MVPA and Ohio Motorpool members “Dan’s Division” located in Fitchburg, Massachusetts. Dan’s Division has been very active in Ohio events over the past 20 years. Participating in parades, funerals, and taking an active part in the D-DAY Ohio event.

Activities have been carried out by two brothers, Dan and Steve Desgroseilliers, along with the back bone of the Division, their father Paul.

Dan and Steve made many trips to events in Ohio each year and Dan was an active Crew Member on the LST 325. Serving as a Snipe in the engine room, making numerous trips when the ship was on its annual tours.

A huge loss was felt with the passing of Dan in 2016. His passing created in his memory, the family name of “Dan’s Division”.
