

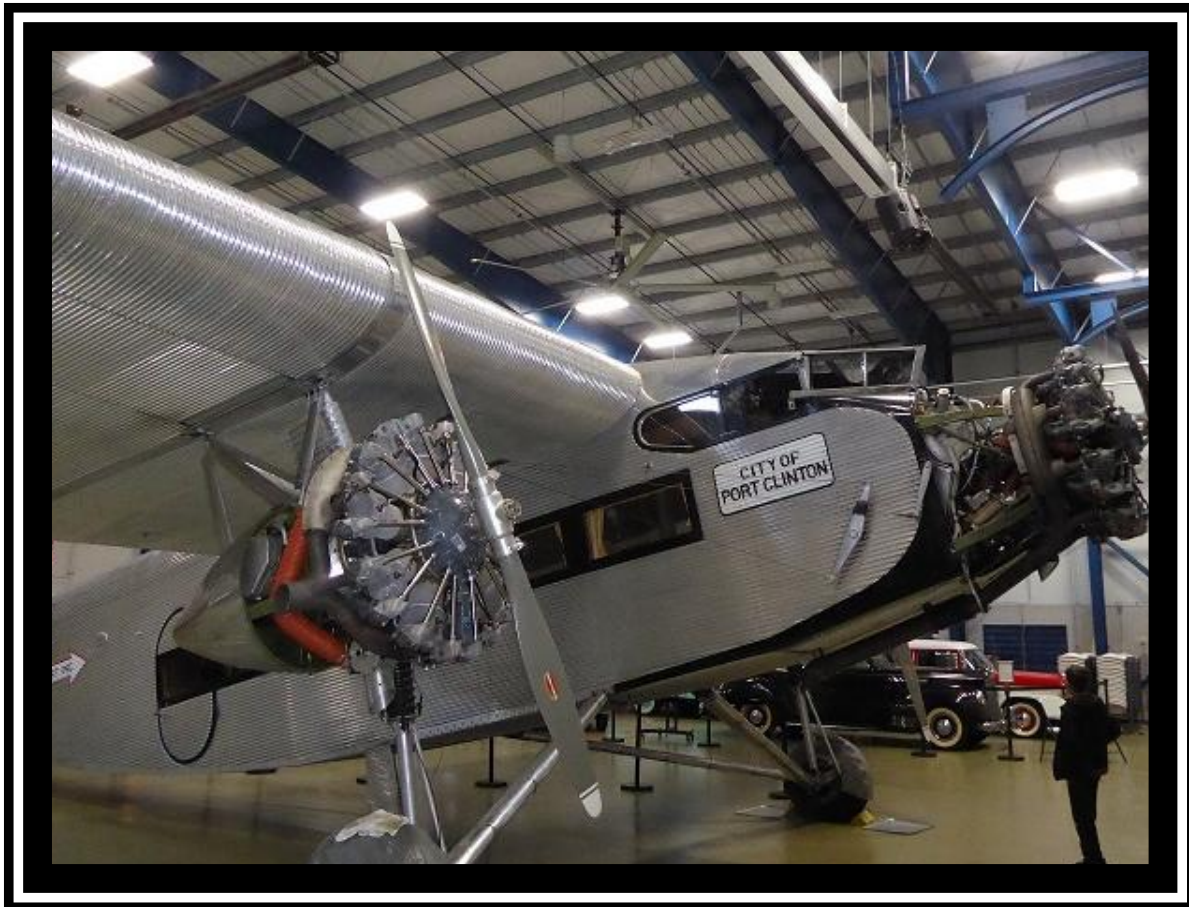

*Adding to the list of recuperating* - Chuck Monique along with Chip Lytle and Lee Stober so please keep them in your thoughts and prayers for complete recovery.

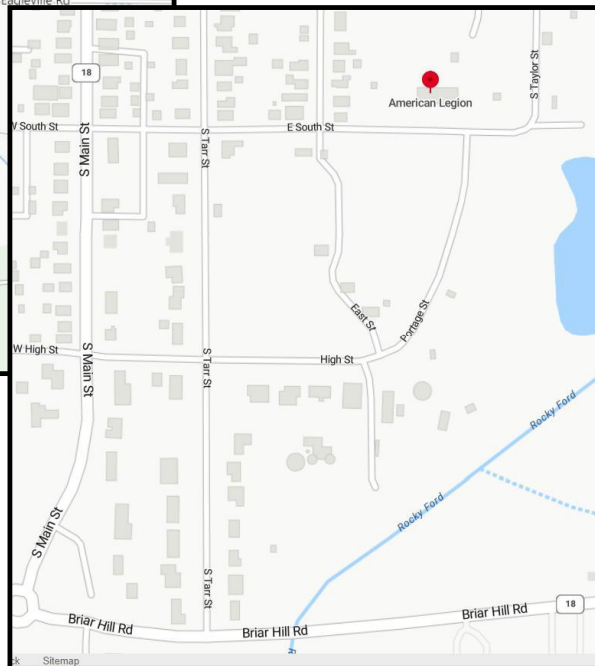
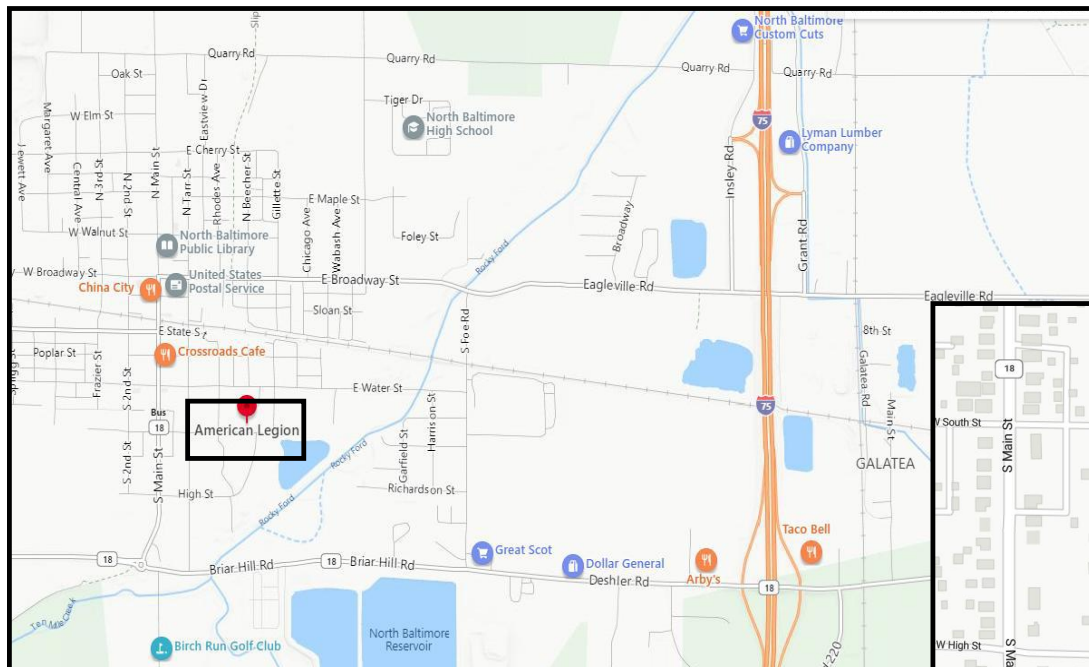

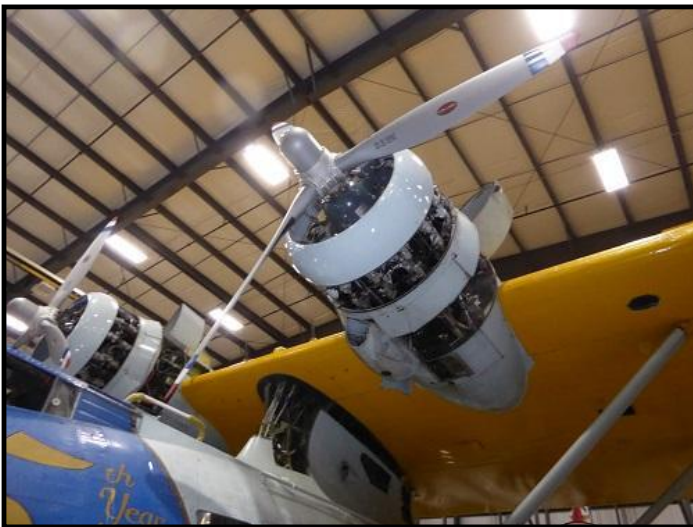

Bottom photos are of just some of the many displays out in Hanger 2.







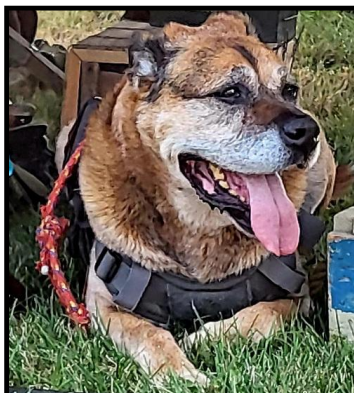

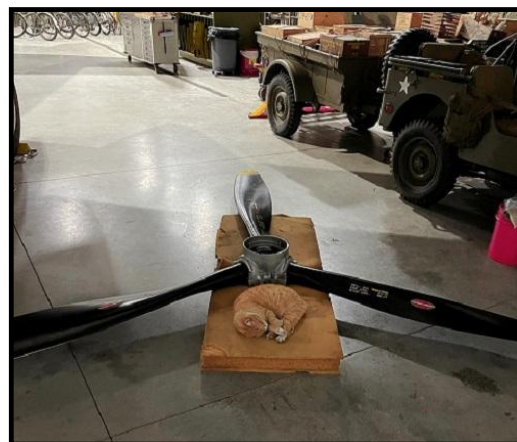
